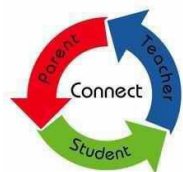


What is a Family-School Compact?

The Title I Compact is an agreement which parents, students and teachers develop together. It explains how parents and teachers will work together to ensure all students reach grade level standards.

Effective Compacts:

- Link to goals of the School Improvement Plan
- Focus on student learning skills
- Describe how teachers will help students develop those skills using high-quality instruction
- Share strategies that parents can use at home
- Explain how teachers and parents will communicate about student progress
- Describe opportunities for parents to volunteer, observe, and participate in a partnership which inspires their child to succeed.

We guarantee an empowering environment that ensures that each student has the opportunity to acquire the skills necessary to become career and college-ready, and a responsible, productive, global citizen able to cope with changing social and economic conditions. Measurable goals for the (2023- 2024) school year are as follows:

- By May (2024), 60% or more of enrolled students will earn a Level 3 or higher on Reading EOC.
- By May (2024), 60% or more of all enrolled students will score at level 3 on Algebra I EOC.
- By May of (2024) 60% or more of all enrolled students will score at level 3 or above on Biology EOC.

This compact pledges our school community to increase academic achievement skills so that all students will be proficient by the end of the school year. BETA will provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables children to meet Florida's student academic achievement standards.
